Garand, Springfield, Vintage Military Rifle And Modern Military

CMP Sanctioned Match

May 16 2026

Registration begins at 8:00 a.m. Competition begins at 9:00 a.m.

This is a Civilian Marksmanship Program as-issued sanctioned match. CMP Rules and Course of Fire apply.

Equipment: CMP eligible as-issued military rifles, including the M1 Garand, 1903 or 03A3 Springfield, M1 Carbine, Vintage Military Bolt-Action rifles, including Krag, U.S. Model 1917, Enfield, Swiss K-31, Mosin-Nagant, all Mauser varieties, Arisaka, and others. Iron sights only. Basic AR15 Type Rifles With Or Without Scope up to 4-1/2 Power, Ak, SKS, Basic M1A ,All Legal For **MODERN MILITARY**. All highpower-style equipment may be used — e.g., shooting coats, stools, mats, spotting scopes, gloves.

— but is not required. Some equipment will be available to borrow.

Course of Fire: 100 yards on the SR-1 bullseye target. 35 rounds, including sighters.

5 sighting shots in 5 minutes

10 slow-fire prone shots in 10 minutes, each shot is single-loaded

10 rapid-fire prone shots, including a reload, in 80 seconds

10 slow-fire standing shots in 10 minutes, each shot is single-loaded

A note on the rapid fire stage: In CMP sanctioned matches all shooters who are able begin the rapid fire stage standing, and move into the prone position on the “commence firing” command. M1 Garands begin with two rounds loaded under a closed bolt. Bolt action rifles begin with five rounds loaded, with an open bolt. M1 Carbines begin with five rounds in a magazine under a closed bolt. Garands reload an eight round clip, bolt action rifle reload five additional rounds, Carbines insert a second magazine with five rounds. Garand shooters should have two en-bloc clips. Bolt action rifle shooters should have one or two stripper clips for the caliber they are using. Carbine shooters should have two magazines. Some clips and magazines will be available to borrow.

All shooters will be able to shoot at least two entries. Additional entries may be permitted based on space available.

CMP Achievement Medals will be awarded to all competitors who meet or exceed Achievement Award scores in effect at the time of the match. There will also be Club Medals presented to the top three Marksmen along with Club Medal for high Women (must be 2 women shooters to eligible) and Club Medal for high Junior Shooter.
